**Mile #5**, "WHERE" can you get help? Don't go it alone. You don't have to. There are many no-cost and low-cost <u>sources of help</u> in your community and on the <u>web</u>. Check out <u>SCORE</u> and <u>SBDCs</u>. Google search for free training webinars. Ask your friendly NH Vocational Rehabilitation counselor for some suggestions.

**Mile #6** (...and the best part!), "WHEN" will you know that you succeeded? Think about it. Are you looking to make "X" amount of money each month from this activity? How much would you have to make or hours would you have to sell to generate this much? Do you like what you're doing? Do you like who you're selling to? Who is there to help you? Are your family and friends a part of your success? How many new and enjoyable relationships are possible in this self-employment adventure?

Celebrate all of the good things that come about as you take this journey down the river. The possibilities are endless and you can count on having a great boss - **YOU**!
